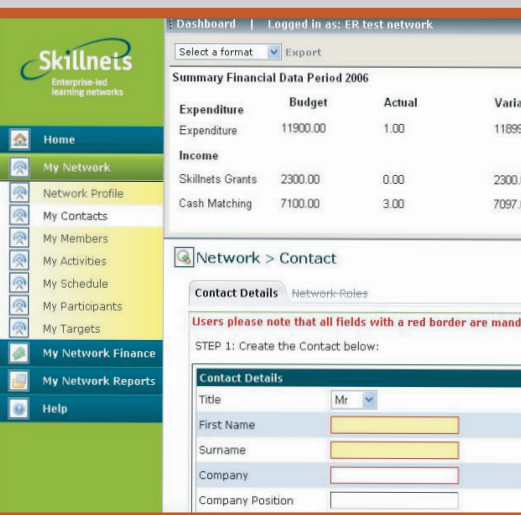


Skillnets, Dublin



Skillnets is an enterprise led support body dedicated to the facilitation of enterprise training and workplace learning. It was established in 1999 to encourage and add impetus to Irish business's drive towards the adoption of best practice standards in human resource development. The organisation is led by employer and employee stakeholders – IBEC, CCI, SFA, CIF, ICTU – in partnership with the Department of Enterprise Trade and Employment and receives funds from the National Training Fund.

Brief:

Specification, Programming and Implementation of a web based Bespoke Software System. The main function of the system is the capture, storage and management of all data relating to Skillnets' Training Networks, Trainees Training Activities and Financial records throughout Ireland. This includes:

Solution:

- Input and management of all data relating to Network members and trainees
- Scheduling and assessment of Network training activities
- Management of all Network income and expenditure items
- Network Bank reconciliations
- Custom Reporting tool, including graphical reports
- Personalisation of system for each User
- Online application forms
- System generated alerts program based on customised business rules
- Outlook style user interface and graphic design
- System administration user privilege that enables Skillnets to maintain and update the system contents and essential business rules with minimum recourse to programming resources

Hosting package comprising:

- Dedicated Enterprise Level Application Server
- Dedicated Enterprise Level Database Server

The system was programmed in ASP.NET 2.0 using a SQLServer 2000 database
